Both my husband and I love our country and The United States, we love life and freedom.

You excellence, I take the occasion to congratulate all the people who together with my husband were rewarded with Presidential Medal of Freedom, for having contributed to humanitarian and significant causes to the world, such as the noble cause of Human Rights, Freedom and Democracy.
